WELCOME TO VANCASSO PRESETS

Thank you for purchasing a Vancasso preset. Whether you've chosen one individual look, a full preset pack or a bundle, this guide will help you get everything installed and ready to use.

Presets are your starting point. Apply the look, then fine-tune it for the photograph in front of you.

BEFORE YOU START

Download the files supplied with your purchase and save them somewhere easy to find. If your download arrives as a **ZIP file**, unzip or extract the folder first.

Your preset files are designed to be imported into Lightroom. You do not need to open the preset files individually.

LIGHTROOM CLASSIC - DESKTOP

01 Open Lightroom Classic

Launch Adobe Photoshop Lightroom Classic on your computer.

02 Go to Develop

Select a photograph and open the **Develop** module.

03 Find Presets

Locate the **Presets** panel on the left-hand side.

04 Import

Click the **+** icon next to Presets and choose **Import Presets**.

05 Choose Your Files

Locate your downloaded Vancasso preset files, select them and click **Import**.

06 Start Editing

Your Vancasso presets should now appear in the Presets panel. Select a photo and click a preset to apply it.

LIGHTROOM - DESKTOP

1. Open Adobe Photoshop Lightroom and select an image.
2. Open the **Presets** panel.
3. Open the preset options menu.
4. Choose **Import Presets**.
5. Locate your downloaded Vancasso preset files and import them. They will then appear in your preset library.

LIGHTROOM MOBILE

EASIEST METHOD

If you use the same Adobe account on desktop and mobile, install your Vancasso presets on Lightroom Desktop first. Once Lightroom syncs, your presets should become available in the mobile app automatically.

Open Lightroom Mobile, select a photo, open **Presets** and locate your Vancasso presets.

DIRECT MOBILE IMPORT

Depending on your version of Lightroom Mobile, you may also be able to import preset files directly. Open an image, go to **Presets**, open the preset options menu, choose **Import Presets**, then select your downloaded Vancasso files.

RECOMMENDED EDITING WORKFLOW

| 1 | APPLY
Choose the Vancasso preset that best suits the image. |
| 2 | EXPOSURE
Adjust the brightness so the image sits where you want it. |
| 3 | WHITE BALANCE
Fine-tune Temperature and Tint for the lighting and skin tones. |
| 4 | REFINE
Adjust highlights, shadows, contrast, colour, masks or crop where needed. |
| 5 | EXPORT
Export your finished photograph and share your work. |

MATCH DAY

The Everyday Essential.

Clean, vibrant and balanced - a go-to game-day look that helps players, kits and the pitch pop.

STADIUM

Feel The Atmosphere.

Rich colour, crisp detail and added depth designed to bring the crowd, pitch and stadium energy to life.

FLOODLIGHTS

Own The Night.

Created for evening and night games under challenging artificial stadium lighting.

GOLDEN HOUR

Chase The Light.

Enhances warm tones and natural sunlight for a rich, glowing outdoor finish.

GRIT

Raw. Dark. Powerful.

Deeper tones, stronger contrast and a darker edge for intense sporting moments.

CLEAN CUT

Less Noise. More Image.

A refined, natural and professional finish that keeps colours true and details crisp.

INTENSITY

Make It Hit Different.

Punchier colour, stronger contrast and extra impact for action that needs to jump off the screen.

FINAL WHISTLE

More Than The Game.

Moody, cinematic tones for celebrations, emotion and storytelling beyond the action.

A QUICK TIP FROM FIZ

Don't feel like you have to use the same preset for every image from a shoot. Experiment. Different lighting, colours and moments can call for completely different looks. The preset gives you the foundation - your adjustments make the final image yours.

QUICK TROUBLESHOOTING

I can't see my presets after importing.

Restart Lightroom and check the Presets panel again. Also confirm that you imported the preset files rather than trying to open them separately.

The preset looks different on my photograph.

That's normal. Camera settings, exposure, white balance, lighting, skin tones and location all affect the result. Start by adjusting Exposure and White Balance after applying the preset.

My presets aren't appearing on mobile.

Make sure desktop and mobile are signed into the same Adobe account and allow Lightroom time to sync. If your app supports direct preset import, you can also import the files on mobile.
